

SPECIFICATIONS

AUTO PARTS: STOCK & EMERGENCY DELIVERY

Prior contracts for specific parts, if presently in effect with the Town (i.e.): International Truck parts, filters, alternators, generators, Komatsu, etc.) will take precedence if duplicated in this price list.

All parts are to be new except when rebuilt is specified. All products to be first line products.

Prices submitted will be based on percent (%) **OFF** the "jobber" price or percent (%) **ABOVE** "Warehouse Discount" (WD) price.

Bidder to indicate which price list being used, and percentage of either discount or increase.

Vendor to include jobber/WD price sheets (on disk) of ALL MANUFACTURERES THAT THEY BID. Vendors not supplying this may have their bid eliminated. Price sheets or discs to be clearly labeled as to Bid#, Vendor, Bid item#, mfg.

VENDORS NOT INCLUDING THE PRICE SHEETS MENTIONED ABOVE **IN THEIR BID** MAY HAVE THEIR BID ELIMINATED.

The successful bidder to furnish a minimum of three (3) set price lists to be distributed to various departments.

Successful bidder to supply original invoices if requested to do so.

Vendor to guarantee delivery of "emergency delivery" parts within thirty (30) minutes of receipt of an order . Delivery of stock items must be made within five (5) business days of receipt of an order.

Price changes will be implemented as per manufacturer's increases or decreases. The vendor is responsible to submit the required number of updated replacement price lists.

Inventory Control: Vendor agrees to adjust inventory up to 5% of annual purchases (full credit) Handling charges to be negotiated on returns exceeding 5%.

The successful bidder must provide the Town of Babylon with proof of Product Liability insurance in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00), naming the Town of Babylon as "additional insured".

Awarding: The Town will take a sampling of items to determine lowest responsible bidder.

Any bidder found imbalancing the bid in any of the unit prices will be cause for bid rejection.

The Town may award this bid in whole or in parts, or make no award at all, whichever is in the best interest of the Town.
