

**SPECIFICATIONS
TOWING SERVICES FOR TOWN OF BABYLON VEHICLES
AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT**

The intent of this bid is to pick-up Town of Babylon vehicles and heavy equipment from any location in the Town of Babylon and take them to the Fleet Maintenance Yard, 1223 N. Indiana Ave., Lindenhurst, N.Y. or any other site located within the Town of Babylon.

Vendor must be capable of towing cars, large trucks and heavy equipment. Vendor is to submit a complete list of all equipment and vehicles to be used in connection with this contract.

A representative from the Town of Babylon, Fleet Services, will notify vendor with location and vehicle to be picked-up. Vehicles must be picked-up within 30 minutes of notification.

If low bidder is unavailable, the Town shall then go to the next low bidder. However, this is not meant to encourage unwarranted refusals to answer a call because of a location or type of pickup. Vendors are to be cautioned against repeated refusals, as records will be kept and this contract award may be withdrawn from a vendor who fails to perform as per specifications.

Under no circumstances are vendors allowed to sub-contract.

The successful vendor must comply with all Federal, State, County rules and regulations and Town Ordinances.

All bidders must submit current copies of Town of Babylon Tow Truck Licenses. Failure to do so may be cause for your bid to be rejected.

The successful bidder must maintain a valid Town of Babylon Tow license for the entire term of the contract. Failure to do so, may cause the termination of the contract. The successful bidder must have a valid Certificate of Occupancy for a public garage and/or tow business.

The successful bidder must comply with all insurance requirements as per the attached.

Copies of all valid registrations and insurance cards for all vehicles to be utilized shall be submitted with this proposal. Copies of N.Y.S. Drivers License for all tow truck drivers with "S" endorsement shall also be submitted. Failure to do so may be cause for your bid to be rejected

In addition, the apparent low bidder must provide the Town with copies of the driver's licenses, for all principals of the company.

The Town may award this bid in whole or in parts, or make no award at all, whichever is in the best interest of the Town.
